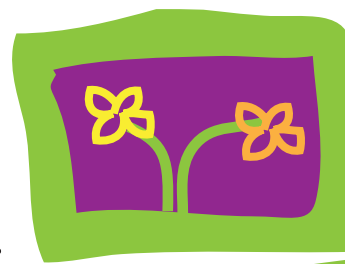


INVENTING with COMPUTERS
